

Whether it is one pet pig or 1000 pigs, you can help keep our pigs safe. Before entering a pig shed or coming into contact with pigs:



shower thoroughly and wear clean clothes



scrub your boots, making sure they are are free of soil and other contaminants



wash your hands with soap or use hand sanitiser



clean and disinfect equipment



adhere to the farm's biosecurity requirements.

Familiarise yourself with prohibited pig feed regulations in your state or territory.

- Do **not** feed pigs swill which is any meat, or any food containing meat.
- Do **not** feed pigs imported dairy products unless it was legally imported for stockfeed purposes. If you are unsure, check with your supplier.

These simple steps can help prevent serious diseases including African swine fever and foot and mouth disease which would devastate Australia's pig industry.
